



Home Repair Program Eligibility Criteria

NEED

Recipients are required to complete an application and must meet the following eligibility guidelines. Applications are not deemed complete until all requested documentation is received.

- Meet the program population requirements.
- Low to moderate household income and assets as defined by U.S. Federal Poverty Guidelines as Average Median Income (AMI) of 80% or below.
- Proof of Income. Income of all adult members must be disclosed. Married or cohabiting individuals must complete a joint application.
- Proof of Identity.
- Own and/or permanently reside in the home for which repair is requested. Written consent from any non-applicant owners will be required prior to commencement of work. Exception: yard work, ramps and rails projects may be completed at rental properties with the property owners' written consent and waiver of liability.
- Eligible properties are Single Family Residences. Manufactured homes will be considered on a case-by-case basis and scope of work and year of construction will be considered.
- Applicants who own multiple real estate properties are not eligible.
- Homeowner must be current with the following:
 - Mortgage Loan Payment (if still making payments)
 - Property Taxes
 - HOA dues if applicable
 - Proof of Residence within the identified ECHH service area.
- Proof of honorable or general under honorable conditions discharge, typically Form DD-214 (Military Veterans Only).
- Consent to a Sex Offender Background Check of all adult members of the household.
- Applicant will sign an agreement not to sell the home for three (3) years after completion of repairs. This requirement may not be applicable for ramp construction.
- Funding source may require additional information.

WILLINGNESS TO PARTNER WITH HABITAT

- The homeowner or service recipient must provide the required information by given deadlines.
- Homeowner/recipient must agree to partner with Erath County Habitat for Humanity to complete sweat equity as listed below:
 - At least one person from the household needs to be onsite by appointment to work on the project along with the volunteers. The homeowner, or an appointed family member or friend, will contribute to sweat equity hours. If there is a physical challenge to helping with repairs, homeowner and/or appointed family member will work with ECHH to determine an alternate way to perform sweat equity. This may include homeowner or appointee serving as host for workday, helping with sign in of volunteers, and providing cool water for workers.
 - For safety reasons, children under the age of 16 years old are not allowed on the construction site while construction is in progress. Children between the ages of 16 and 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Home Repair Program Eligible Repairs

EXTERIOR (First Floor Only)

- Minor siding and trim repair and replacement; replacing wood members
- Exterior scraping, caulking, and painting
- Handrails at property entrances
- Replace wood damaged by termites (after recent termite treatment) and dry rot, including sill, frames, etc.
- Window repair (new screen, glass, glazing) or replacement
- Gutter replacement/repair
- Porch, deck, or wheelchair ramp construction
- Repair or replacement of porch, stairs, or ramp
- Door repairs or replacements
- Weather-stripping at doors
- Caulking and foaming cracks and gaps at the doors and windows
- Adding or replacing door seals

Repair Exclusions:

- Foundation repairs
- Roof repairs
- Repairs above the first floor of the residence
- Cosmetic or decorative repairs and modifications
- Construction or demolition of rooms and additions
- Remodeling improvements not related to health, safety, or accessibility needs
- Repairs on properties that are uninhabitable
- Repairs on properties with open permits
- Repairs on properties undergoing current construction, renovation, or remodeling
- Repairs on properties in a state of incomplete construction, renovation, or remodeling
- Repairs on properties which Habitat deems unsafe for staff, volunteers, or contracted professionals
- Homes that are "red tagged", condemned, uninhabitable and/or with extensive damages over the program limit are not eligible.
- Property cannot currently be under construction, renovation, or remodel OR in a state of incomplete construction, renovation, or remodeling activity.
- The budget for total material cost on the entire project will be based on need.
- Mold Remediation
- Lead based paint removal
- · Asbestos testing or abatement

INTERIOR (First Floor Only)

Bathroom grab bars
Handrails at building exits
Plug-in carbon monoxide detector

You will need to provide proof of total household income by providing **copies** of the supporting documents listed below. Your application will be considered incomplete if the documents are not provided with the application.

 - o Child Support, TANF
